remarkable clarity to a big and messy subject new insights and hard hitting conclusions about the resistance to democracy make this essential reading for anyone interested in the roots of our current dilemmas lynn hunt author of history why it matters for centuries people in the west identified freedom with the ability to exercise control over the way in which they were governed the equation of liberty with restraints on state power what most people today associate with freedom was a deliberate and dramatic rupture with long established ways of thinking so what triggered this fateful reversal in a masterful and surprising reappraisal of more than two thousand years of western thinking about freedom annelien de dijn argues that this was not the natural outcome of such secular trends as the growth of religious tolerance or the creation of market societies rather it was propelled by an antidemocratic backlash following the french and american revolutions the notion that freedom is best preserved by shrinking the sphere of government was not invented by the revolutionaries who created our modern democracies it was first conceived by their critics and opponents de dijn shows that far from following in the path of early american patriots today s critics of big government owe more to the counterrevolutionaries who tried to undo their work

we seem to be losing the ability to talk to each other about and despite our political differences the liberal tradition with its emphasis on open mindedness toleration and inclusion is ideally suited to respond to this challenge yet liberalism is often seen today as a barrier to constructive dialogue narrowly focused on individual rights indifferent to the communal sources of human well being and deeply implicated in structures of economic and social domination this book provides a novel defense of liberalism that weaves together a commitment to republican self government an emphasis on the value of unregulated choice and an appreciation of how hard it is to strike a balance between them by treating freedom rather than justice as the central liberal value this important book critical to the times provides an indispensable resource for constructive dialogue in a time of political polarization

we speak of being free to speak our minds free to go to college free to move about we can be cancer free debt free worry free or free from doubt the concept of freedom and relatedly the notion of liberty is ubiquitous but not everyone agrees what the term means and the philosophical analysis of freedom that has grown over the last two decades has revealed it to be a complex notion whose meaning is dependent on the context the oxford handbook of freedom will crystallize this work and craft the first wide ranging analysis of freedom in all its dimensions legal cultural religious economic political and psychological this volume includes 28 new essays by well regarded philosophers as well some historians and political theorists in order to reflect the breadth of the topic this handbook covers both current scholarship as well as historical trends with an overall eye to how current ideas on freedom developed the volume is divided into six sections conceptual frames framing the overall debates about freedom historical frames freedom in key historical periods from the ancients onward institutional frames freedom and the law cultural frames mutual expectations on our right to be free economic frames freedom and the market and lastly psychological frames free will in philosophy and psychology

debates about freedom an ideal continually contested were first set out in their modern version by the eighteenth century french philosopher jean jacques rousseau his ideas and analyses were taken up during the philosophical enlightenment often invoked during the french revolution and still resonate in contemporary discussions of freedom this volume first published in 2010 examines rousseau s many approaches to the concept of freedom in the context of his thought on literature religion music theater women the body and the arts its expert contributors cross disciplinary frontiers to develop thought provoking new angles on rousseau s thought by taking freedom as the guiding principle of their analysis the essays form a cohesive account of rousseau s writings

modern woman was made between the french revolution and the end of the first world war in this time the women of europe crafted new ideas about their sexuality motherhood the home the politics of femininity and their working roles they faced challenges about what a woman should be and how she should act from domestic ideology to women s suffrage this book charts the contests for woman s identity in the epoch shaping nineteenth century

officials assumed the helm of international drug control after world war ii at a moment of unprecedented geopolitical influence embodied in the growing economic clout of its pharmaceutical industry *we sell drugs* is a study grounded in the transnational geography and political economy of the coca leaf and coca derived commodities market stretching from peru and bolivia into the united states more than a narrow biography of one famous plant and its equally famous derivative products coca cola and cocaine this book situates these commodities within the larger landscape of drug production and consumption examining efforts to control the circuits through which coca traveled suzanna reiss provides a geographic and legal basis for considering the historical construction of designations of legality and illegality the book also argues that the legal status of any given drug is largely premised on who grew manufactured distributed and consumed it and not on the qualities of the drug itself *drug control* is a powerful tool for ordering international trade national economies and society's habits and daily lives in a historical landscape animated by struggles over political economy national autonomy hegemony and racial equality *we sell drugs* insists on the socio historical underpinnings of designations of legality to explore how drug control became a major weapon in asserting control of domestic and international affairs

riccardi draws a broad gauged fork through a variety of thinkers who have spoken wisely or foolishly on suicide justin martyr and augustine aquinas and luther calvin and kierkegaard dostoevsky and camus and so on obviously here is the riskiest portion of such a study but the author has had the witty humility to give his reader excellent selections from these figures and has provided just the right frequently brilliant commentary on them to facilitate an encounter between them and the reader on the central issue of the meaning of christ's freedom for the problem of suicide david willis professor emeritus princeton theological seminary
